Aiming to develop learners with academic excellence, bilingual communication skills and world-class capabilities in the 21st century.

Sombat Thamrongthanyawong (1994, referenced in Phromnil 2017a) said that the important factors affecting the quality of education that the world over pays attention, but Thailand is unsuccessful.

- 1) Quality of instructors normally, those who have a teaching career must have good academic results or be good learners. Famous schools all over the world will try to select talented people to be teachers. In the past, Thailand, whoever is studying, teachers must be talented in order to attend, but in the recent period, we are not able to attract talented people to study teachers, especially basic education. There is always affected the quality of our education, while Korea has been very successful in attracting talented people to teach.
- 2) Curriculum and teaching system is a modern curriculum that is consistent with the needs of society and has a teaching system that enhances thinking, analysis and synthesis skills, focusing on learners in the center, but the main problem of the learning system Thai teaching is an examination to memorize. Lack of thinking and analytical skills resulting in creativity.
- 3) Learners have different skills, but educational philosophy considers that all people born are all capable of being a duty of families and schools to find out what skills they have and then encourage them to have opportunities to develop according to people's skills to the fullest ability, all children will have the opportunity to achieve their goals, but our main problem is that many children do not have the opportunity to develop their aptitude skills that make a person lacking capacity.
- 4) Factors promoting teaching and learning, such as libraries, science laboratories, laboratories, laboratories, sports equipment and people, etc. Schools with complete teaching and learning factors will help to provide high quality and efficient teaching, but the school or many educational institutions are unable to properly procure such teaching and learning factors do not have the quality of education.
